The Poultry Place is a retail and wholesale poultry production facility located just outside of St. Jacobs, Ontario, in the heart of Mennonite country. The company was first established in 1985 as a small chicken farm located in Clinton, Ontario. Nick Den Boer, owner/operator, would maintain the farm throughout the week, and then drive to the Waterloo Farmer's Market on Saturday mornings to sell his products. By 1989, The Poultry Place had moved to St. Jacobs, where they opened up a retail outlet, and expanded to include St. Jacobs Farmer's Market as well as the Waterloo Market.

After a few busy years of trying to balance it all, The Poultry Place decided to take a step back, concentrating on the retail store and leaving the Farmers' Markets behind. While the majority of their retail business is from in and around the Waterloo region, they have begun to focus on building up their wholesale business, delivering to 15 specialty meat shops across the province, including a shop in Thunder Bay.

Today, The Poultry Place is owned by Nick's son, Sebastian and his wife, Tiffany. They

have created a wide assortment of unique poultry products including seven varieties of chicken sausage, four types of wings, and eight different kinds of stuffed chicken breasts. The Poultry Place is a proud supporter of the Homegrown Ontario™ program. Their fresh and frozen chicken and turkey products are IQF, free-ranged, drug free, and made from only the finest poultry of local farmers.
